

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

## **Class Specifications**

## **Hunter Divisions**

The rated sections of this competition are official USEF point competitions for USEF National and USEF Zone Horse of the year Awards Programs. All classes will be operated under applicable US Equestrian, USHJA and Zone II rules. All hunter classes to be judged on performance and soundness. Hunter Courses will consist of at least eight fences with changes of direction. Fences will simulate obstacles found in the hunt field, such as brush, post and rails, walls, in and outs, gates, etc. Course diagrams will be posted no later than 30 minutes before the class. In some cases the area of the courtesy circle may be restricted by a dotted line. Under saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. 1. HUNTER CLASSES will be judged on performance and soundness. Any additional specifications will be noted.

2. HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIPS will be awarded in accordance with USEF RULE GR808.

3. STABLING - All stalls will be on first come, first serve basis. Stalls must be reserved and paid by August 1, 2021. Stalls may sell out prior to August 1. NO REFUNDS. All stalls come with doors. Stalls must be stripped clean prior to departure.

4. PRIZE MONEY will be awarded in the office. Checks must be cashed within 30 days or will not be honored.

5. A computerized jumping order will be assigned in all "classes".

6. Hunter courses may include brush, coops, in and out, stone wall, log, gates, and will be posted at the in-gate at least one hour prior to each class.

7. Jumper courses may include post and rail, gates, oxer, wall, panels coop, or any other combination of the above.

8. COURSES AND FENCES. The Committee reserves the right to change the obstacles or vary the courses at their discretion.

9. SCHOOLING will be permitted only in the areas provided by the committee and only over practice jumps therein.

10. NO REFUNDS will be considered without a vets note. THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS ON STALLS for any reason.

11. The committee reserves the right to cancel any class when in its judgment the entries are inadequate and to combine or divide any class or classes should the best interest of the show or the rules of the USEF require it.

16. A processing fee of \$75.00 will be made for all non-negotiable checks. Any returned checks not "made good" within 10 days will be forwarded to the USEF for collection per USEF Rule XV, Art. 1508.

17. Dogs must be leashed.

18. Monmouth at the Team and Centenary University will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Monmouth at the Team Horse Show and Centenary University harmless for any illness, loss or accident which may occur by fire or otherwise.

19. USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Operating of such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harms to others. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
